Effective Date:

The University Council approved resolution CUSP 2016-17I designating Labor Day as a nonclass day and re-stating the number of class days as 71 days in the fall term and 72 days in the spring term.

THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, the University Calendar criteria be revised as follows:

- Labor Day be stipulated as a non-class day.
- Restate the number of class days in a term to 71 days in the fall and 72 days in the spring.
- Summer term to be defined as one term that may be divided into a variety of different periods in addition to the traditional Summer I and Summer II schedules.
- All other calendar criteria remain as previously stated:
 - o The Fall Commencement Ceremony shall be scheduled after the completion of final exams whenever possible.
 - o Fall semester shall include a long weekend break in October to allow a short break.
 - The fall semester shall contain a one-week break for the Thanksgiving holiday. The spring semester shall contain a one-week break approximately halfway through spring semester.
 - o No class days are held on Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
 - There shall be at least two days between the end of spring semester examinations and the spring commencement. This necessitates a Saturday examination day.

- There shall be no scheduling of Spring Commencement on the same weekend as Commencement at Radford University.
- o There will be no classes on Memorial Day and Independence Day.

Revision 1 approved April 10, 2017; effective Fall 2017

- Stipulates Labor Day as non-class day
- Formally there was a requirement for an equal number of days in the fall and spring terms. This revision re-states the number of class days as 71 in the fall term and 72 in the spring term.
